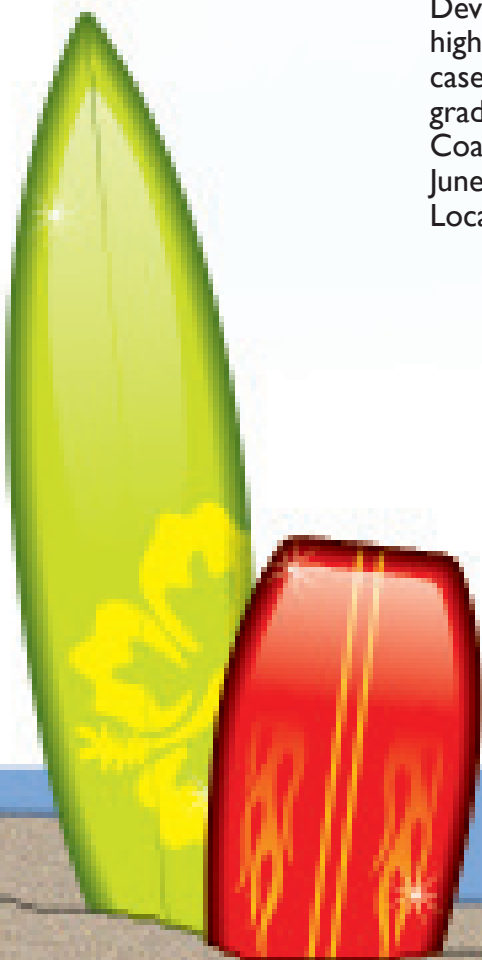
SEBC Adv. Skills Basketball Camp **\$80**

King’s Knights Youth Soccer Camp

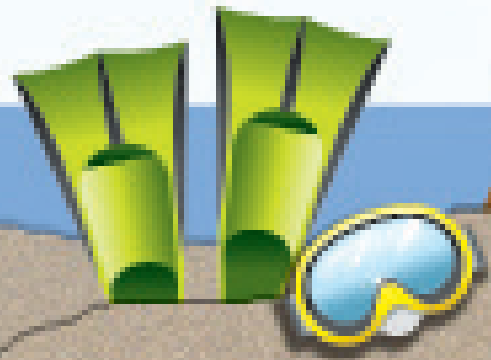

Complete form on pages 15-16. Billing is handled through King's Business Office at the end of each month for King's students. Pre-payment is required for all non-King's students.

Academic & Enrichment and Sports Camps

Complete form on pages 17-18. Full payment is due upon registration.

Registration and payment are arranged directly with music teachers. See Music Lessons on pages 12-13 for more information.

To most efficiently staff and prepare for all summer programs, registration should be completed by Friday, May 22, 2009. After May 22, space may be available until programs are full. Registration for any open camp will close two business days before it is set to begin. If you register before May 22, then you will be notified of your confirmed registration. To fully prepare you and your child, your family will receive a detailed packet of program information shortly before the program begins. Please provide us your email address.

Refund Policy

Refunds are given when we must cancel a camp. A camp may be cancelled due to lack of enrollment. The decision to cancel a camp due to lack of enrollment is made after Friday, May 22, 2009. Full refunds are given if we must cancel a camp. Refunds are not given if your family's plans change and your child may no longer participate in our Summer Program.

Transfer Policy

To transfer from one registered week to another we must receive the request at least 10 business days before either week begins. Refunds are not given on transfers and any balance must be paid in full at the time of the transfer. Payment on a transfer may not be applied to extended care fees. Full refunds and/or transfer options are given when we must cancel a camp.

Enrichment Class Size

Each weekly Enrichment Camp must have a minimum of 8 and a maximum of 12 campers enrolled.

School-Age Day Camp

SummerBreak begins at 9:00 a.m. and ends at 3:30 p.m. Daily attendance is logged through the sign-in/out sheets located in the Elementary School Office at the SummerBreak desk. King's parents will be billed for SummerBreak fees through the Business Office at the end of the month. Pre-payment is required for all non-King's students. All SummerBreak staff and campers go on field trips.

Before-and-After Camp Extended Care

Cost of care is \$6.75 per hour per child. The extended care program opens at 6:30 a.m. and closes at 6:00 p.m. The extended care program is a drop-in program, and is logged through the daily sign-in/out sheets located in the Elementary at the SummerBreak desk. King's parents will be billed for all extended-care fees through the Business Office at the end of the month. Non-King's parents pay daily for care.

PAYMENT: Full payment of total program fees must be paid at the time of registration. Registration must be completed by Friday, May 21, 2010. Checks should be made payable to King's Schools. REFUND POLICY: Refunds are provided only in the event of class cancellations.

BEHAVIORAL GUIDELINES: Families must abide by all King's Schools policies and guidelines. Parents are expected help their campers follow all guidelines.

HEALTH/ILLNESS GUIDELINES: Parents must report any serious or infectious illnesses to the Director of Special Programs immediately. Campers must not attend King's camps if showing signs of a serious cold or other communicable disease. Campers with a temperature of 100 degrees or more will not be accepted at King's camps. If Campers become ill while at King's camps, parents must make arrangements for their immediate pick-up. Campers returning to King's camps after illnesses which require prescribed medication must have started medication no less than 24 hours before returning to King's camps.

King's Schools does not discriminate in the admission of Campers based on race, color, national origin, sex, age, or disability or any other protected class status as governed by federal and state law.

WAIVER, RELEASE, ASSUMPTION OF RISKS & INDEMNIFICATION: I, the parent or legal guardian of _____ (“Camper”), agree as follows: I acknowledge and understand that certain activities, including but not limited to, use of playground equipment, field trips and other King’s Schools camps activities, can be hazardous and may result in injury, including loss of life. I voluntarily assume any and all risks of loss, damage or injury while Camper is on the premises.

In consideration for Camper’s participation, I represent that I am the parent or legal guardian and hereby release and forever discharge CRISTA Ministries, King’s Schools, King’s Kids Club and their servants, employees, officers, directors, trustees and all other persons or entities acting on their behalf (collectively referred to as “CRISTA”), from any and all claims, actions, damages, liabilities, costs or expenses and attorney fees which are related to, arise out of, or are in any way connected Camper’s viewing or participation in any activities. By signing this Agreement, it is my intention to waive any rights I may otherwise have to sue or seek damages from CRISTA; except where injury, death or disability results from CRISTA’s gross negligence.

I further agree to indemnify, hold harmless and defend CRISTA against any and all claims for damages, costs, expenses or attorneys fees brought by any third party in connection with or arising out of Camper’s involvement or participation. Moreover, in consideration for Camper’s participation in activities, including the use of equipment and facilities, I further agree to indemnify and hold CRISTA harmless from any and all claims which are brought by, or on behalf of Camper and which are in any way connected with such use or participation by Camper. This Agreement shall be effective and binding upon my marital community, estate, heirs, agents, personal representatives and assigns.

EMERGENCY CONSENT: _____ (Camper’s name) may receive emergency or routine medical care from a licensed physician or emergency facility if I cannot be reached in an emergency situation. Such emergency or routine care includes emergency surgery, administration of medications or other measures as determined necessary by a licensed physician. I agree to assume the responsibility for all medical, transportation and rescue-related expenses incurred on behalf of Camper.
